Cardiologists diagnose and treat cardiovascular diseases. Their work includes identifying conditions like abnormal heart rhythms, blocked blood vessels, and heart murmurs. Treatment may involve managing heart failure, post-heart attack care, and recommending procedures such as stent placement, heart surgery, catheterization, and angioplasty.

When should I consult a cardiologist?

Consult a cardiologist if you experience chest pain, dizziness, palpitations, or shortness of breath; have high blood pressure, chronic kidney disease, or peripheral artery disease; have a history of smoking or diabetes; have a family history of high cholesterol or heart disease; or lead a sedentary lifestyle. These are all potential indicators requiring expert cardiac evaluation.

What to expect at my first visit to a heart specialist?

Your initial consultation with a cardiologist will involve a thorough review of your medical history and an assessment of coronary artery disease risk factors. Expect to have your heart rate and blood pressure checked, and an electrocardiogram (ECG)

may be performed. A comprehensive cardiac and vascular physical examination will also be conducted.

How do cardiologists diagnose blocked arteries?

Cardiologists employ various diagnostic tests to identify arterial blockages. These may include: angiogram, echocardiogram (often with a stress test), electrocardiogram (ECG), chest X-ray, ultrasound, CT scan, MRI scan, and blood tests such as lipid profiles to assess cholesterol levels. A PET scan may also be utilized.
