Obstetrician/gynecologists specializing in reproductive endocrinology and infertility, and holding relevant certifications, can treat women's infertility. This specialized training is required for fertility treatments.

Women should have an annual gynecological checkup, including a pelvic exam, to detect potential health issues or abnormalities early.
