9. What are the educational requirements to become an ophthalmologist?

Ophthalmologists must first earn a five-and-a-half-year MBBS degree. This is followed by a postgraduate MD (Doctor of Medicine), MS (Master of Surgery) in Ophthalmology, or DNB, a three-year program, requiring a competitive entrance exam. Some institutions also offer diplomas in ophthalmology following the MBBS.
