Apollo Hospitals' pediatricians provide care for children from birth through age 18. Infants (0-2 years) may require frequent visits, while well-child checkups are typically annual from ages 2-5 and beyond. Annual visits are recommended until the child turns 18.

9. Can a Pediatrician Perform Surgery?

Pediatricians focus on children's physical and mental health. While some pediatricians, with specialized surgical training, may perform procedures, pediatric surgeons are specialists in surgical interventions for children. Pediatricians primarily use non-surgical methods. Pediatric surgeons' expertise ranges from minor procedures (e.g., foreign body removal) to complex surgeries (e.g., cardiac surgery).
