Consult a cardiologist if you experience chest pain, dizziness, palpitations, or shortness of breath; have high blood pressure, chronic kidney disease, peripheral artery disease, or diabetes; have a history of smoking; have a family history of high cholesterol or heart disease; or maintain a sedentary lifestyle. These are all potential indicators of cardiovascular issues requiring expert medical attention.

9. What to expect at my first visit to a heart specialist?

Your initial consultation with a cardiologist will involve a thorough review of your medical history and risk assessment for coronary artery disease. Expect a physical exam focusing on your cardiovascular system, including blood pressure and heart rate checks. An electrocardiogram (ECG) may also be performed.

10. How do cardiologists diagnose blocked arteries?

Cardiologists employ various diagnostic tests to identify arterial blockages. These may include non-invasive imaging techniques such as echocardiogram, electrocardiogram, chest X-ray, ultrasound, CT scan, and MRI scan. Invasive procedures like angiogram may also be used. Blood tests, such as lipid profiles for cholesterol screening, and PET scans can provide further insights into cardiac health and the presence of blockages.
